the lookout later for some learning about Farms and pets. Maybe we will find out more things about our class pet!

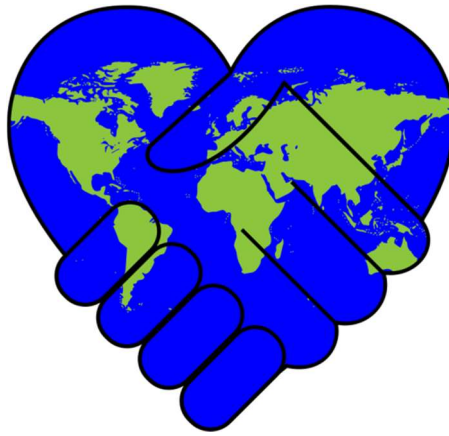
